Encourage Environmental Responsibility: We will promote sustainability awareness within our supply chain and prioritize suppliers who demonstrate environmentally responsible practices. We will integrate sustainability issues within our subcontractor and supplier evaluation and appointment process.

Engage with our Supply Chain: We will engage with material suppliers and service providers to identify low-carbon techniques or products on offer that can support the realisation of our business and project specific carbon and environmental targets.

Design for Sustainability: Where we have design responsibilities within our projects, and when possible, we will specify products which are made from material with high recycled content, which can be reused or recycled at end-of-life and ensure the chosen design optimises the efficient use of materials and resources.
